

CAN YOU BE FOUND IN AN EMERGENCY?

One question that is asked when you call "9-1-1" for assistance is: "What is your address?" Many addresses in our area require that the caller give the 911 dispatcher detailed information on how to find their driveway or access road in order for emergency responders to provide rapid assistance. Instructions like. "Take the third driveway from the intersection and turn right and then go to the second left and we live in the blue house."

The Graeagle Fire Department will be making available reflective address signs and mounting post (if needed) to all interested property owners of the fire district. These signs are installed at the beginning of the driveway or common access road to properly indentify your residence from the street. If the common access serves several homes, it may be necessary to place additional signs to clarify the entrance to your home.

Our goal is to have all occupancies with LEGIBLE and VISIBLE addresses. To achieve this goal, we ask for your assistance. *Please fill out your application form, and return it, along with a check for each sign ordered to:*
